

Boddington Lions Rodeo Overflow Camping Frequently Asked Questions

Where do I find information about booking camping?

How do I book overflow camping?

Overflow camping is booked through TryBooking. In the booking system, campsites are referred to as “tickets”.

Please note: Camping bookings must be made online and are not available for purchase over the phone.

Do camping tickets include entry to the Boddington Lions Rodeo?

No. Please purchase tickets to the event from the event organiser through their website www.boddingtonlionsrodeo.com.au/

What does “4 tickets per site” mean?

Each campsite can accommodate up to 4 people in total. Tickets represent people, not separate bookings or Rodeo entry passes.

Do I need to book all 4 tickets?

No. You only need to book for the people in your group. The remaining capacity in your campsite will be automatically reserved for you.

Can someone else book the remaining tickets on my site?

No. Once you book a site, any remaining capacity is held and cannot be purchased by others.

Can I book the remaining tickets on my site?

Yes. Once you book a site, any remaining capacity is held and can be opened for purchase by request by emailing caravanpark@boddington.wa.gov.au

Can I book with friends on the same site?

Each campsite should only be booked by one person from each group. If we identify multiple booking names on the same site, later bookings may be moved.

What happens if we book separately?

You may be allocated different sites depending on availability at the time of booking. To camp together you should book at the same time or in the same session where possible. We will do our best to group sites together, but this cannot be guaranteed.

How do I book multiple sites for my group?

If you're booking sites as part of a group, try to book all of your sites at the same time or in one transaction if you can.

You can spread your group across multiple sites depending on:

- Number of people.
- Number of vehicles.
- Type of equipment (e.g. caravans, tents).

Example:

If you have a group of 10 people travelling in 5 caravans, you should book 5 sites, with 2 people per site.

This ensures you stay within the vehicle limits for each site while giving everyone enough space and keeping your group together.

How many vehicles are allowed?

Maximum 2 vehicles per site (e.g. car + caravan, or 2 cars).

Are generators allowed?

No. Sites are unpowered, and generators are not permitted.

Are dogs allowed?

No. Dogs are not permitted at the event or within the overflow camping areas.

Registered service dogs are exempt.

What size are the sites?

Each site is approximately 8m x 6m. Please ensure all tents, swags, vehicles, and equipment fit within this space.

Are there showers?

No. Showers are not available in the overflow camping areas.

Are there toilets?

Yes. Portable ablution facilities will be provided for campers.
